

Incident Management (IM) Trainings available on MyODP ODP Announcement 21-071

AUDIENCE:

All interested stakeholders

PURPOSE:

To announce the release of additional Incident Management (IM) Bulletin trainings on the MyODP website which focus on incident response, medication management, and target separation.

DISCUSSION:

Two new IM Bulletin training courses are available on the MyODP website at the following path: Training > Intellectual Disability> Incident Management/Risk Management > Incident Management Bulletin 00-21-02.

The first course is titled *Responding to Incidents* and is relevant for all stakeholders. This course contains a series of four webcasts. The series also introduces two guides that are intended to assist individuals and families.

The ***Responding to Incidents*** course includes the following series of webcasts:

- Part 1 – A Culture of Safety
- Part 2 – Immediate and Emergency Responses
- Part 3 – Supporting Victims
- Part 4 – Keeping the Individual/ Family Informed and Documentation

The *Responding to Incidents* course also introduces two helpful guides:

- **Incident Management Family Guide** – *When Something Bad Happens to Someone I Care About or Support* - This guide was developed to provide families information about incident management processes and help guide a discussion. This guide is referenced throughout the series.

- **A Guide to Victim's Assistance** - This guide was developed to provide support team members information about resources available to support victims of crime that can be access locally. This guide is discussed in Part 3 of the series.

Upon completion of the webcast series, 2.5 hours of training credit will be awarded. Below is a link to the course which contains the webcast series and guides.

The second course is titled **Agency Focused Incident Management Training** and contains two webcasts that are targeted to agency Incident Management Representatives and others who may have a role in agency incident reporting, management, oversight, or monitoring activities.

The course includes the following webcasts that focus on:

- Medication Errors, Failure to Provide Medication Management and Missing/Theft of Medications
- Target Reporting, Separation, and Management
